Why ;La Chispa!?

The Latinx population is the fastest-growing student population in the nation. Unfortunately, the Latinx student population also has a disproportionately high dropout rate. ¡La Chispa's! dual language delivery model values the bicultural experience of Latinx youth and helps to inspire an academic identity!

Student Participants Will:

- Build an academic identity through positive connections with Latinx high school role models
- Engage in a bilingual & biliterate environment designed to promote the value of reading, writing, and speaking in two languages
- Learn leadership and life skills, including goal setting, team building, leadership styles, resiliency, service to one's school and community, and negotiating a bi-cultural existence.

Program Options for 2023 - 2024:

- Option one: School only (open to students in your school).
- Option two: District only (open to schools in your district).
- Option three: Regional event (open to schools in your region).

Program Requirements:

- The program is at a high school, in partnership with High School mentors.
- For programs with 100+ students, the program must be in the main gym, not the auxiliary gym.
- Participants bring their own lunch.
- The school/district takes care of copying materials (for school and district-only events).
